Rules and Regulations

1. All judge's decisions are final. No exhibitor or person shall approach a judge on any matter without show manager's permission. Anyone disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit all entry fees.
2. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if in its opinion the entries to warrant.
3. There will be a post entry fee of \$20.00 for all entries received after 4:00 pm the day before the show. There will be no penalty for entering additional classes the day of the show.
4. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks.
5. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be presented in all classes unless otherwise stated or money given.
6. All exhibitors are prohibited from riding anywhere on show grounds without wearing protective headgear that has passed the current ASTM/SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if said headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until said headgear is properly in place.
7. All dogs must be on a leash.
8. Membership forms and class specifications are available at the secretary's office.
9. Under Rhode Island law, an equine professional, unless he can be shown to have failed to be in the exercise of due care, is not liable for any injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 21, of Title 4 of the General laws.
10. Courses will consist of post, rail, walls, gates, brush and flowers..
11. All riders must present their current RIHA and NEHC membership cards or a copy thereof to the show secretary prior to competing in the RIHA and NEHC medal classes.
12. No exhibitor numbers will be handed out without a signed check or payment of entries.
13. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be handed out in all divisions.
14. Schooling and lunging will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating this rule will forfeit their entry fees and not be allowed to show.
15. Regular classes will be \$25.00. Medal and all money classes will be \$35.00.

Class Descriptions

1. Lead Line Equitation ---RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader shall be on foot and at least 14 years of age. Riders may not compete in any other classes except: Leadline Eq Championship or Lead Line Suitability.

2. Lead Line Equitation Championship-UNRATED

3. Lead Line Suitability-RIHA rated "C"

Open to riders 6 years of age and under. To be shown at the walk and individually at the trot or jog. To be judged with emphasis on suitability and manners of mount. Leader shall be on foot and at least 14 years of age. Riders may not compete in any other class except Lead line.

Walk Trot Equitation--- NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "A"

Open to riders 10 years of age or younger. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No child entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To compete in the Championship class entries must have competed in class #8.

Walk Trot Pleasure---NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to riders 10 years of age or younger. Shall be shown at the walk, trot or jog only. No child entered may compete in any class requiring them to canter or lope. To be judged on manners, suitability of horse/pony to rider and performance. To compete in the Championship class entries must have competed in class #10.

13. RIHA Pleasure-RIHA Rated "C"

Open to horses and ponies usually used for pleasure purposes that are owned by a members of the RI Horseman's Association. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Must be asked to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order.

14 NEHC Open Pleasure Horse or Pony---NEHC rated "C" – NOT OFFERED MAY 17th.

To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with light rein, but still maintaining contact with horse's mouth. Must be asked to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order. All horse's/ponies shall be judged on their respective merits regardless of type.

Hunter Pleasure NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to all horses of hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of the rider. To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance, and soundness. To be eligible for the championship class horse must have been entered and judged in class #15.

Hunter Type Pet Pony---NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability to rider. To be eligible for the championship class you must have competed in class #17.

Junior Exhibitor's Hack -----NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

To be shown under English Tack. To be ridden by children under 18 years of age. May be divided. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring, on a reasonably loose rein but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. To be eligible for the championship class you must have competed in class #87.

41. Junior Exhibitor's Hack \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

42. Junior Exhibitor's Hack Championship \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

20. Pony in Hand -----NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged individually, standing and then at a walk and trot on the line. To be judged on breed type, conformation, quality, substance, way of going, disposition and manners. \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

Pet Type Pony NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

All ponies must be shown by children under 14 years of age. Shall be ridden at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope, both ways of the ring, with excessive speed to be penalized. Shall be judged on manners, suitability to rider, and performance. To be eligible for the championship class pony must have been entered and judged in class #85.

85. Pet Type Pony \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

86. Pet Type Pony Championship \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5

84. Pet Type Pony Trail

Modified Amateur Adult Equitation---NEHC rated “B”/RIHA rated “A”

Open to adult amateurs who, as of Dec. 1st of the current show year, have not won 6 blue ribbons at a recognized show in Adult eq. classes. Including Adult medal classes but excluding Modified adult classes. For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult, if as of Dec. 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3’ or higher within the past 2 years. Fences not to exceed 2’ 6”.

- Riders in this division may not ride in any other classes where fences exceed 2’6”.

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 3’ at a recognized show after Dec. 1st of the current year. Fences not to exceed 2’6”.

Pre-Children’s Equitation – RIHA rated “A”

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Pre-Children’s Hunter and who have not shown over a course where fences exceed 2’3” at a Recognized Show after December 1st of the current year.

Short Stirrup Equitation---NEHC rated “B”/RIHA rated “A”

Open to riders 12 years of age or younger. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18” in height. To be shown over a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 fences not exceeding 18” in height. Fences may be taken at either a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. May be asked to halt and back. No more than eight riders to canter at one time.

Open to amateur riders, eighteen years or older. Fences not to exceed 3’. To be judged in both directions at the walk, trot and canter on the flat. Martingales prohibited in flat classes.

72. NEHC Amateur Adult Medal

Open to adult members of the New England Horseman’s Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3’. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge’s discretion (USEF 1---19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course.

76. NEHC Junior Medal

Open to junior members of the New England Horseman’s Council who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3’3”. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge’s discretion (USEF1-19). To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required to qualify for the finals. Contestants that are qualified are no longer eligible for the preliminary class. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

RIHA Medals - Contestants are required to be current members of the Rhode Island Horseman’s Association, Inc. and meet requirements to qualify for the finals as noted for each division (see RIHA rulebook at www.rihorseman.com).

Adult & Junior Medals: All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3’ with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge’s discretion. (USEF current tests 1-19).

Mini Medal & Adult Mini Medal: All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding eight fences and not less than six fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2 feet 6 inches, with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests may be requested, at the judge’s discretion. (USEF Current test 1-8).

In all divisions: 3 must complete the course to count; riders may continue to ride in the qualifying classes once qualified.

Hunter Divisions

Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter--unrated

Open to junior riders who have not competed in classes which require a rider to jump higher than 2' and to adult amateur riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at a RECOGNIZED show in Adult Equitation classes, including Adult Medal Classes and Modified Adult Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Pre-Adult if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 2'3" or higher within the past two show years. May show a horse or pony. At the same show, the same horse/rider or pony/rider may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Horse or Pony, Pony Hunters, Modified Adult Hunter, Amateur Adult Hunter, or any class where fences exceed 2'3".

35 & 36. Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter over fences \$30, \$25, \$20, \$15, \$5, & 5

37. Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter under saddle

Short Stirrup Hunter- NEHC rated "B"/RIHA rated "AA"

Open to riders 12 years of age or younger. Not to compete in any other equitation class at any other show and has not competed in a jumping class exceeding 18" in height. Fences may be taken at either a trot or canter at the option of the rider. To be judged at the walk trot and canter both ways of the ring on the flat. No more than eight riders to canter at one time.

26,27,28: Short Stirrup Hunter over fences \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5, \$5

30. Short Stirrup Hunter under saddle

Children's Hunter - NEHC/RIHA rated "B"

To be shown by junior exhibitors. Juniors age 15-17 must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 2' for smalls/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, and 3' for horses. Spreads may not exceed fence height. If extras warrant, the division to be split at the discretion of horse show management. Same horse/pony/rider combination may not show in any their rated division except equitation at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into regular Pony Hunter Division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge.

57&58. Children's Hunter Ponies over fences \$20 \$15, \$15 \$10, \$10, \$5

59. Children's Hunter Ponies Handy \$20 \$15, \$15 \$10, \$10, \$5

61. Children's Hunter Ponies under saddle. \$20 \$15, \$15 \$10, \$10, \$5

RIHA Hunter - RIHA rated "A"

Open to members and non-members. Horse/rider combinations. Horse/rider combination is not eligible for any other RIHA or NEHC classes excluding equitation. Open to a horse or rider in their first or second year of showing over fences. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

38,39, & 40. RIHA Hunter over fences. \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5, \$5

49. RIHA Hunter under saddle

Registered Thoroughbred Hunter- RIHA rated "B"

Open to Registered Thoroughbreds. Can be ridden by Junior, Amateur or Professional rider. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability as a hunter. Fences 2'6" with no combinations.

77 & 78. Registered TB Hunter over fences. \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5, \$5

79. Registered TB Hunter under saddle

Modified Pony Hunter- RIHA rated "B"

Shall be judged on manners, suitability to rider, and performance. A pony/rider combination may not cross into any other hunter class over fences except Pre-Children's Hunters or equitation at the same show. Fences to be 2'.

80 & 81. Modified Pony Hunter over fences. \$25, \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5, \$5

82. Modified Pony Hunter under saddle

Hunter Derbies - NEHC/RIHA rated "B"

This is a two round class open to amateur adults and juniors to be shown over a course of ten fences at 2'6" and 2'9" respectively, with the first round judged on performance, hunter pace, and style, quality and substance, and movement, The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. The top 4 or 25% from the first round will return to jump a handy hunter round of eight obstacles which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, light turn option, clever options for jump approach, halt and/or back and walk jump. Judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. To fill a class, at least 4 riders. \$50, \$30, \$20, \$10, \$5, \$5
